

WHAT IS NIEM-UML?


The UML Profile for NIEM Version 2.1 (better known as NIEM-UML) is an Object Management Group (OMG) specification for modelers and developers to produce NIEM-conformant artifacts using the Unified Modeling Language (UML)



NIEM-UML is a specification. It must be implemented in a UML modeling tool in order to generate NIEM-conformant XML schema.




