<b>RMS</b>	If an offender has Unknown values for Age, Race, Sex & Ethnicity, the only allowable relationship is RU = Relationship Unknown or OF=Other family member unknown (Victim refused to identify suspect (family member assumed))
<b>RMS</b>	Only relationships identified in MCA 45-5-206 will be shown as options for relationship types for these offenses.
<b>RMS &amp; Repository</b>	New relationship FIELD for education, healthcare and those who are legally able to care for others have been added to better identify violent crime data related to workers in these fields. Locations have also been added to identify where they are being victimized. Because you may choose more than one relationship, it is important to indicate these relationships as well as the standard relationship types. These fields include Victim Was Education employee/teacher/aid/secretary/administrator; victim Was Power of Attorney designee/guardian; and or victim Was Medical employee/doctor/nurse/pharmacist/healthcare aid/etc.
<b>RMS &amp; Repository</b>	Relationship type will be required for person and property crimes, and will be allowed for society crimes.
