Repository	"Other" injuries will flag narratives to be sent to determine if additional injury categories are needed
RMS	Disorderly Conduct: If no injury and either personal or no weapon, then disorderly conduct (45-8-101). If minor injury regardless of weapon type, then simple assault (45-5-201) with LEO as victim type and LEOKA information must be completed. If major injury or weapon then aggravated assault against peace officer (45-5-210) and LEOKA information must be completed, as well as additional information if a firearm, cutting instrument or blunt instrument were used as the weapon. See injury and weapons tables.
RMS	For Intimidation: (45-5-203, 45-5-206, 45-5-220, 45-7-102, 45-8-403) limit to table options identified.
RMS	MCA 45-5-215 Strangulation: injury types must include at least one of the new strangulation injury types indicated in the injury table. The offense may include other injuries as well. (Additional strangulation injuries based on those identified in the hyperlink. (https://www.domesticshelters.org/articles/health/strangulation-can-leave-long-lasting-injuries))
RMS	Require victim fields for individual or law enforcement person types for person and property crimes.
RMS	Injury types should be limited for certain offenses. See offense table for details
RMS	If 45-5-202, 45-5-205, 45-5-206, 45-5-207, 45-5-210, 45-5-212, 45-5-213, 45-5-215, 45-5-221, 45-5-627 and injury is none or apparent minor, then limit weapon type to all weapons except for personal weapons or none. See weapons table for details.
RMS	Do not require victim fields for society crimes, but allow victim information to be entered including injury. Send all victim information to the repository. The REPOSITORY will send appropriate information to FBI regarding society victims.
RMS and Repository	Upto five injuries can be collected per victim.
