NV NIBRS

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The Nevada Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program has provided technical specifications for the transmission of NIBRS data in alignment with the FBI's National Incident-Based Reporting System Technical Specification manual (**Version 1.0, dated 03/30/2018**). Nevada's technical specifications include data changes and additions to the standard FBI NIBRS Program. These changes affect some existing FBI data elements. The additions are required to fulfill state mandated data collection and reporting per Nevada Revised Statutes. This document includes a section highlighting all changes and additions by segment, and a detailed list of the specifications by segment.

Data validation checks should be completed at the agency level, within the law enforcement agency's Records Management System, and at the state level, within the State of Nevada Repository system. These validation checks should ensure all FBI and state mandated data elements conform to the specifications laid out by the FBI in their NIBRS Manual and Technical Specifications, and the specifications laid out in this document.

The Nevada UCR Program currently uses a manual process to aggregate and analyze crime data. To facilitate the more complex NIBRS format a new online central data repository and database is scheduled to deploy in the 1st Quarter of 2019. The data repository application will consist of a web-based user interface and database. Agencies will export the **NIBRS XML** from their Records Management System and log into the data repository web interface and upload the file. The system will process the file immediately and show any errors as they are found. Agencies can then correct these errors and upload the file again.

The State of Nevada has provided a mapping of each crime offense to the appropriate NIBRS code. This mapping was done by using the Nevada Offense Code (NOC) file. In its current form, the NOC (pronounced “knock”) Table has been used for over 7 years within the Nevada Criminal Justice Community. It provides a single, comprehensive catalog of all crimes that a person can be charged with and adjudicated by Nevada state and municipal courts.

Usage/Purpose			
<p>Under Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 33.018 a Domestic Violence (DV) incident is defined by relationship and includes language that describes DV as <i>any knowing, purposeful or reckless course of conduct intended to harass the other person</i>. This DV definition can include certain NIBRS offenses that are within the Crime Against Society category.</p> <p>Since person information is not collected for Crimes Against Society, the DV1 must be added to gather the person information required by NRS 171.1227.</p> <p>The offense code "DV1" is not sent to the FBI, but remains in the data repository.</p>			
Example			
<p>A husband injures a wife's pet in her presence with the intention of harassing her. Because of their relationship and the intent of the crime this will be coded as a Domestic Violence incident. The NIBRS offense code reported is 720 - Animal Cruelty (Crime Against Society). Nevada specific offense code of "DV1" is added to the incident to gather information required by NRS 171.1227</p>

Domestic Violence Card Given	Mandatory if the incident is Domestic Violence. Yes/No question indicating whether or not a Domestic Violence Card (some times referred to as a blue card) was given to the Offender.

Was Offender Primary Aggressor	Mandatory if the incident is Domestic Violence. Yes/No question must be answered indicating whether the primary offender was arrested.
Reason Primary Offender Not Arrested	Mandatory if the incident is Domestic Violence AND Primary Aggressor is NOT arrested. The reason for no arrest must be indicated. Choices are: A (Aggressor of the incident undetermined), G (Offender was gone upon arrival of the officer), N (No evidence of injury to the victim), R (The Offense was not reported within 24 hours), O (Other), (U) Unknown.
